FirstLook Lung is a simple blood test that helps doctors decide if you need a lung scan. The test works differently based on your age because cancer risk changes as we get older.

What Your Results Mean

What does an **"Elevated"** result mean?


This test does not diagnose cancer. The results (Elevated or Not Elevated) help your doctor decide if they want to get a picture of your lungs with a low-dose CT now or if they can wait.

What does a **"Not Elevated"** result mean?

A not elevated result means there's a lower chance that lung cancer would be found on a scan right now. Your risk can still change over time, especially if you keep smoking. You should still get checked for lung cancer every year.


